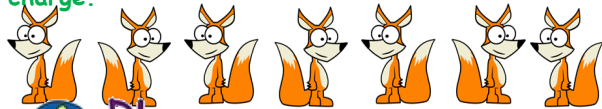

SAFE TRANSFER OF CARE

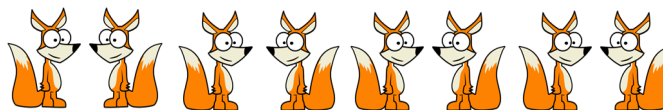

Breakfast Club

Age Range: 4– 10

Staffing Ratio: 1:8 as a minimum. All staff are suitably qualified and experienced.

Breakfast club opens at 7:45am each morning and runs until the start of the school day. Our Breakfast club Manager is ably assisted by a team of Play Leaders who ensure that the children are provided with a healthy breakfast and engaged in a variety of fun, age appropriate activities until it is time for school.

Children can help themselves to a selection of toast, preserves, cereal, fruit and fruit juice all freshly prepared on the premise. Our youngest children will receive all the support they need to ensure they eat a healthy nutritious breakfast.
