Winter Options:

Abbeywood Rio sweatshirt / cardigan
White/navy Abbeywood polo shirt
Grey trousers / skirt / pinafore
Black school shoes (trainers or boots are not suitable)
Plain black / grey / dark blue socks or tights

Summer Option:

Abbeywood Rio sweatshirt/cardigan
White/navy Abbeywood polo shirt
Grey school shorts/ skirt / pinafore / trousers
Plain black / grey / dark blue / white socks
